According to a 2010 decision by the State auditor, the Village cannot provide us with a donation. Thus, more than ever, we depend on the kindness of friends — and strangers. Programs included presentations by Chuck D'Imperio about Important People of Central New York, John Taibi regarding railroad history, and Mike Kicinski about local businesses. Other events included an antiques appraisal sponsored by Q.S.M.A. and a joint venture with the Earlville Opera House, involving presentations at the Opera House by Patti Lockwood-Blais and Rose Wellman.
